Description: Resilient Georgia's April 2025 General Meeting will showcase five regional coalitions leading efforts to foster trauma-informed workplaces and systems across the state. Resilient Middle Georgia will highlight strategies for advancing trauma-informed leadership, while Resilient Chattahoochee Valley will focus on creating supportive workplaces for direct service professionals. Aligning Community Systems for Resilience will share approaches to strengthening educator resilience through healing circles. Cobb Collaborative will discuss efforts to enhance trauma-informed practices within the juvenile court system, and Atlanta Regional Collaborative for Health Improvement (ARCHI) will present on their person-centered model integrating social, physical, and mental health care.
